Murfreesboro, Tennessee, September 7, 2011

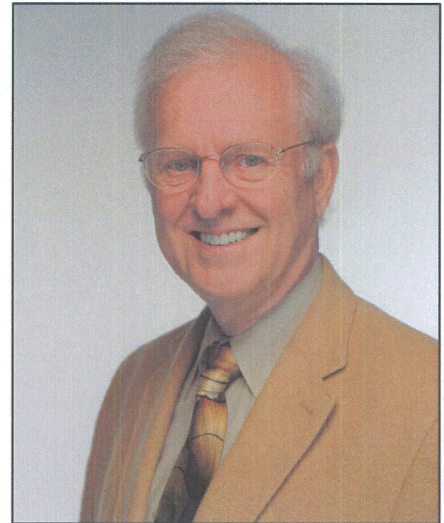
